July 5, 2018 - For the first time in North America, a drone light show will be part of an air show when EAA AirVenture Oshkosh 2018 presents up to 100 lighted drones in flight during night air shows on July 25 and 28, creating another only-in-Oshkosh experience.

The night air shows at AirVenture have become a favorite of Oshkosh attendees, featuring a new perspective on the precise flying skills displayed by aerobatic pilots. Great Lakes Drone Company, based in Wauvliet, Michigan, will be flying the drones and is one of just two U.S. companies authorized by the FAA for such displays.
