News From Headquarters

Scholarship Information

October 3, 2019 - Thanks to the great work done by EAA chapters through the Ray Aviation Scholarship program and unwavering support from the Ray Foundation, program funding for 2020 has been increased from \$1 million to \$1.2 million.

The boost in funding from the Ray Foundation comes after only seven months of program operation. As of early October, 96 youths have been awarded a Ray Aviation Scholarship. Of those scholars, nearly 20 have earned their private pilot certificate, while an additional 50 have completed their first solo. Building off these early successes, EAA and the Ray Foundation look forward to growing chapter and scholar participation in 2020.

The \$1 million core fund will continue to work the same way it did last year, with EAA chapters able to apply for a \$10,000 scholarship grant to fund a qualifying Ray scholar's flight training. The chapter application will be open from November 1 to January 31, 2020, and scholar nominations will open March 1, 2020. Scholars must be nominated prior to November 1, 2020
