Loss of Control in Homebuilts Program Video January 17, 2019 - In this special presentation from the Pilot Proficiency Center (PPC) at EAA AirVenture Oshkosh 2018, a panel of aviation safety experts discuss loss of control (LOC) accidents in homebuilts. LOC is the leading cause of fatalities across all of aviation, but is particularly prevalent in amateurbuilt aircraft.
