#### **News From Headquarters**

August 15, 2019 - At EAA Air Venture Oshkosh 2016, EAA CEO and Chairman of the Board Jack J. Pelton with Suchit Jain of DS SolidWorks and David Kasinskas of GSC announced that EAA members would have free access to the SOLIDWORKS Student Design Kit — EAA Maker Edition.
